**SUBJECT**  
 Control No. 317564- Re - Amendment request by NRC FORM 314, dated October 7, 2008, regarding request to terminate their NRC license, License No. 24-18087-01.

**SUMMARY**  
 In a telephone conversation with Mr. Halstead on this date, he confirmed that the Cs-137 Std source, Ser. No. 3560279B-05, and the Co-57 flood source, Ser. No. 58400994-03, identified in the above referenced NRC FORM 314, were the only sealed sources that had been possessed and used in the NRC licensed activities and that neither source was leaking based on routine leak tests, current as of the time of transfer of both sources to Ste. Genevieve County Memorial Hospital, shortly after the sale of the equipment, including these sources, to the subject hospital. Mr. Halstead also confirmed that only short lived radionuclides, primarily Tc-99m, was used in the scanning procedures, with the last receipt and use being over three years ago and that the licensee no longer possess any licensed material.
