Dear Mr. Eveleigh:

Enclosed is Amendment No. 06 amending your NRC Material License No. 24-26074-01 in accordance with your request. Please note that the changes made to your license are printed in **bold** font. Be aware that license condition no. 11 addresses requirements for authorized use of material. Item 8 of your August 22 letter slightly conflicts with licensed condition 11, and you should be aware that you are required to comply with the license, notwithstanding the statement made in Item 8 of your letter.

Also, in accordance with a telephone conversation between me and Mr. Mike Scheele of your staff, it is our understanding that the Company has disposed of the krypton-85 devices previously identified in Item 7.A and 9.A. in amendment number 5. Therefore we have deleted this material from your license. However, Mr. Scheele stated that he would forward to our office for review and filing, documentation demonstrating that this material was appropriately transferred to a licensed recipient. Please submit this information for our review as soon as possible.

Please review the enclosed document carefully and be sure that you understand all conditions. If there are any errors or questions, please notify the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, Region III office at (630) 829-9887 so that we can provide appropriate corrections and answers.
