




The **2000 Population by Age, Race** and Hispanic Origin report, prepared in February 2002, analyzes the general population results of Census 2000 and changes that have occurred since 1990. The population of Westchester County has reached its highest level at 923,459. Significant findings are: 1) the Hispanic population grew from 86,194 to 144,124, a 67% growth over the decade; 2) the school age population increased by 34,004 persons during the decade, a 26% increase. Data tables, graphs and municipal thematic maps are provided in the report.
