**SITE SPECIFIC MITIGATION MEASURES TO ADDRESS WELL LOCATIONS AND OTHER FACILITIES**

All permanent above-ground structures (e.g., production equipment, tanks, etc.) not subject to safety requirements will be painted to blend with the natural color of the landscape. The paint used will be a color which simulates the standard environmental colors established by the BLM for visual resource management. The colors selected for the Savageton 3 and 4 PODs are Covert Green (PANTONE for Architecture Color Guide 18-0617 TPX) or Carlsbad Canyon (Munsell Soil Color 2.5Y 6/2).

No construction materials will be needed for well pad construction; surface and subsurface soils will be sufficient. Surface disturbance will be kept to a minimum. It will be necessary to dig a small pit to contain the drill cuttings from the well. The cuttings will be buried in the pit.

No construction materials will be taken from Federal and/or Indian lands without prior approval from the appropriate Surface Management Agency. If production is established, construction materials, which may be required for surfacing of the access road and installation of production facilities, will be purchased from a local supplier having a permitted source of materials in the area. For the roads for this POD, Lance anticipates utilizing a commercial gravel pit or the Shrober Pit for a gravel source. Should a change to this plan be made, appropriate notifications will be made.

It is anticipated that no new access roads for transportation of these construction materials will be required.

An existing staging area, approved under Savageton 1, will be used for this project. It is located in the NENE of Section 23, T45NR74W.
