Yes, this does resolve my comment and you need not record my comment in the Federal Register. However, Florida typically requires confirmatory surveys for facilities who have used unsealed radioactive materials with a half-life in excess of 60 days. as required in Part 2 of our rule, 64E-5, Florida Administrative Code.

Mr. Vause,

You are correct, we did not perform or have anyone else perform a confirmatory survey. The guidance when to perform a confirmatory survey is listed in NUREG-1757 Volume 1 (<http://www.nrc.gov/reading-rm/doc-collections/nuregs/staff/sr1757/v1/>). The basis for performing or not performing confirmatory survey is determined by the decommissioning class of that facility and on the basis on information provided. This facility is a decommissioning class 2, which in our guidance does not require a confirmatory survey. The surveys were comprehensive and the facility had little use of material. Does this resolve your comment or do you wish your comment to be recorded in the environmental assessment which will be published in the Federal Register?
