SUBJECT: SUMMARY OF CLOSED MEETING WITH WESTINGHOUSE ON
AIRCRAFT IMPACT ASSESSMENT, NOVEMBER 6, 2008

On November 6, 2008, the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission held a closed meeting with Westinghouse to discuss their aircraft impact assessment. The meeting was closed due to discussion of security-related information. The list of attendees is provided in Enclosure 1. The presentation materials used during the meeting are provided in Enclosure 2 (withheld from the public)(ML083450729).

Westinghouse discussed the analyses they had performed that formed the basis for the conclusions presented in Appendix 19F of the AP1000 Design Control Document (Revision 17); namely that aircraft impact would not inhibit AP1000's core cooling capability, containment integrity, spent fuel pool integrity, or adequate spent fuel cooling. The staff asked a number of questions about the analyses. An inspection of the detailed supporting information will be conducted at a later date.
