
We wish to acknowledge receipt of License No. SNM-98 issued June 26, 1957, covering our enriched cold scrap pilot operation.

We do not know whether this specific information is required to be inscribed on the license in view of the wording of Item 10, "Conditions".

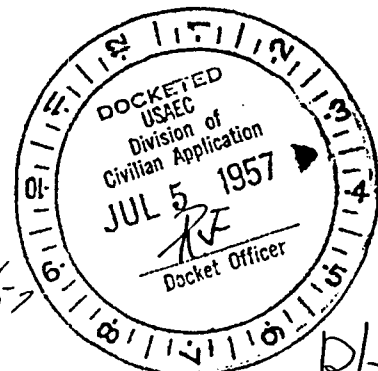
