ENGELHARD INDUSTRIES, ATTLEBORO, MASSACHUSETTS INVESTIGATION ON JULY 19, 1960, IN REGARD TO HIGH FILM BADGE READINGS FOR TWO EMPLOYEES

A letter to the licensee concerning the subject investigation was prepared but not sent out. The reason for withholding the letter was the concern that Engelhard might confuse citations and statements concerning the investigation with compliance action in progress concerning the initial inspection conducted on November 19, 1959, at the licensee's facilities.

A letter will be sent to the licensee concerning the incident investigation on July 19, 1960, and acknowledging receipt of their December 22, 1960, report of a more recent radiation overexposure. Included also, will be confirmation of steps outlined in their letter of November 30, 1960, for correcting air survey deficiencies found during the inspection conducted on November 19, 1959, at the licensee's facilities.
