SUBJECT: License SNM-98

It has been called to our attention by the Inspection Division, New York Operations Office, that there is a discrepancy in our License SNM-98 in relation to the location at which some of the work is performed.

The place of use is noted as being in "licensee's chemical refinery at 149 Murray Street, Newark 5, N. J.". That is correct (except that the Post Office Department has changed the zone number from 5 to 2) insofar as it concerns the major chemical processing operations under the license. However, the same license covers our use of enriched uranium as isotopic standards in our Spectrograph Laboratory, which is actually located at the 113 Astor Street address. The 113 Astor Street address is not shown as a point of use.

At the suggestion of the Inspection Division, we therefore apply for change in our License SNM-98, noting the location of the Spectrograph Laboratory, 113 Astor Street, as being an authorized place of use.

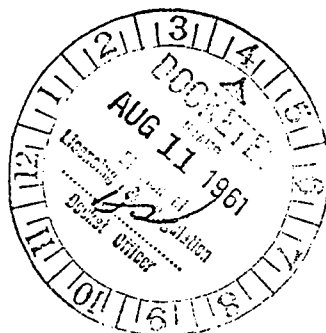
