

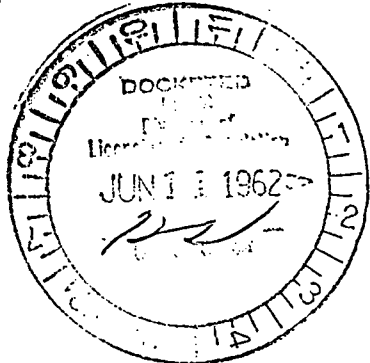

Gentlemen:

We have your form letter, Subject: Notice of License Expiration, dated May 29, 1962, regarding SNM-98, which expires on July 31, 1962.

On May 21, 1962, by letter to Mr. J. C. Clarke, Manager, New York Operations Office, we notified the Commission that the management of Engelhard Industries has decided to withdraw from the uranium scrap refining operation.

We expect that it will take from two to three months to complete the treatment and disposal of the various scrap, residues, and other miscellaneous material which we have on hand in the plant. We, therefore, suggest that SNM-98 be extended in its present form until December 1, 1962, which should see us through completion of the work and clean-up of the plant.

If you have any other suggestions, we should be pleased to hear from you.
