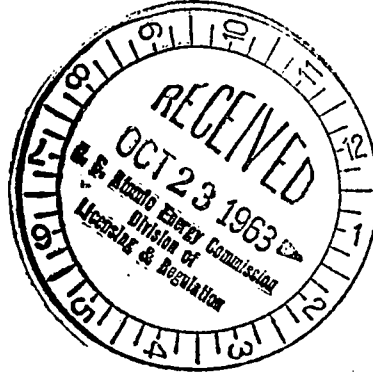

Would you be good enough to advise us what further steps are required in order to terminate finally are mutual responsibility with regard to this license.

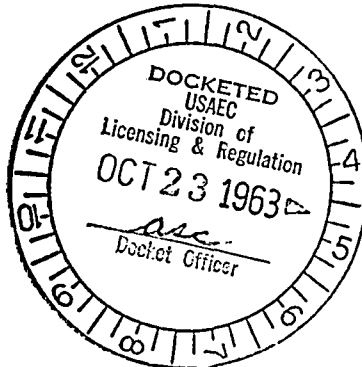

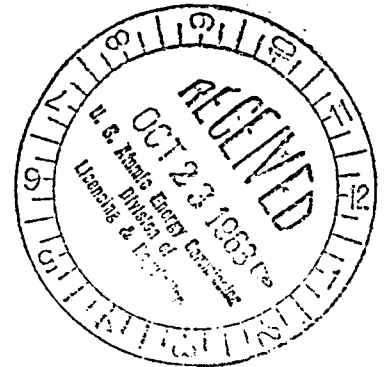
