Attached for your information is a report of an inspection conducted on October 25, 1963, by Region I, Division of Compliance, to determine the current status of the Engelhard facilities with respect to termination of their license SNM-98. The decontamination work has been done by the Radiological Service Company, Incorporated.

The only piece of equipment remaining to be disposed of is a washing machine in the "stone" Building. This washing machine will be disposed of because its configuration does not permit a complete survey and it must be assumed to be contaminated with special nuclear material. This machine will be disposed of by the Radiological Service Company.

Mr. L. Burman, Sales Manager of Engelhard Industries, has been asked to report to Region I as to the final disposition of this item.
