 - Roles, responsibilities, & communications
 - Involvement of site security, operations, and State & locals in scenario development.
- Use of “All Clear”
- Site security and operation’s liaisons foster communications to and from ICP/UC.

Part 1: NRC Observations cont'd

- Use of alternate facilities (offsite) by emergency response organizations.
- Site Security drill participation
- Incident Command Post/Unified Command integration.
- Integration of ICP/UC into offsite protective action decision-making process.
- Accountability of site personnel
- Access control of ICP and credentialing of responders
