SUBJECT: SUMMARY OF PUBLIC SCOPING MEETINGS RELATED TO THE
COMBINED LICENSES APPLICATION REVIEW FOR LEVY
NUCLEAR PLANT, UNITS 1 AND 2

The U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) staff conducted two scoping meetings related to the environmental review of the Levy Nuclear Plant, Units 1 and 2 (LNP) combined licenses (COL) application submitted by Florida Power Corporation doing business as Progress Energy Florida, Inc. (PEF), a wholly-owned subsidiary of Progress Energy, Inc. The purpose of each meeting was to provide the public with an opportunity to participate in the scoping process by providing comments on environmental issues to be considered while preparing the LNP environmental impact statement.

The public meetings were conducted on Thursday, December 4, 2008, at the Florida National Guard Armory located at 8551 West Venable Street, Crystal River, Florida 33426. Approximately 100 people attended the afternoon meeting and approximately 90 people attended the evening meeting. The participants included NRC staff, NRC contractors from Pacific Northwest National Laboratories and ICF International, members of the public, representatives from PEF, the news media, and local government officials.

During each meeting, the NRC staff made a formal presentation which outlined the overall licensing process under Title 10 of the Code of Federal Regulations Part 52; provided a description of the National Environmental Policy Act of 1969 review process; discussed the environmental requirements outlined in 10 CFR Part 51; and addressed how these requirements would be implemented during the LNP COL review. After the presentation, members of the public were invited to ask questions and provide comments. Questions and comments mainly focused on the COL process, alternatives, transmission, socioeconomics, ecology, water quality, and water use.

Enclosure 3 is a copy of the handouts. Enclosure 4 is a copy of the NRC slide presentation.
