Dear Mr. Weber:


Cimarron Corporation submits the enclosed "Final Status Survey Report for Unaffected Areas". This report is submitted to the NRC for two reasons: 1) to fulfill the requirements contained in the previously approved "Final Status Survey Plan for Unaffected Areas", and 2) to request an amendment to License No. SNM-928 to remove the unaffected areas from the license.

Cimarron Corporation previously submitted the "Final Status Survey Plan for Unaffected Areas" for the Cimarron site in October of 1994. This Plan was submitted to the NRC in order to fulfill the requirements of NUREG/CR-5849 for a final status survey of unaffected areas located at the Cimarron site. The NRC subsequently approved this plan by letter dated May 1, 1995.

The "Final Status Survey Plan for Unaffected Areas" contains the survey and sampling results obtained as a result of fulfilling the requirements outlined in the Final Status Survey Plan. The Final Status Survey Report provides all the data necessary to demonstrate that all radiological parameters have been satisfied for unrestricted use of the unaffected areas.
