Andrea, and Phil,

In the next status report for Bellefonte you should see that the status of the response to rai 2.4.2-2 is changed to "issued/open action applicant." The reason for this change in status is the staff checked the copies of the CD handed out at the workshop, and, contrary to TVA's RAI response, the files mentioned in the response are not on the CD.

The files that the staff was expecting to see on the CD are the GIS 'shape files' for Chickamauga, Nickajack, and Guttersville reservoirs. The staff's recollection is that these files are the GIS layers TVA used to make the bathymetric maps hanging on the walls during the June workshop. Consistent with the October 29, 2008, letter that we sent you regarding the hydrology review, we would like to receive this information so that we can continue our development of simplified/bounding calculations and confirmatory numerical tools necessary to complete NRC's independent evaluation of the PMF and dam breach analyses when the hydrology review restarts.
