SUBJECT: SUMMARY OF PUBLIC MEETING CONDUCTED TO DISCUSS  
ISSUES RELATED TO THE RESOLUTION OF REGULATORY ISSUE  
SUMMARY (RIS) 2001-07, REV. 1 (TAC NO. MD9849)

On December 1, 2008, the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) staff conducted a Category 2 public meeting at NRC Headquarters to discuss issues related to the pending issuance of Resolution of Regulatory Issue Summary (RIS) 2001-07, Rev. 1: 10 CFR 50.75, "Reporting and Recordkeeping for Decommissioning Planning." Approximately 26 people attended the meeting in person or thru a conference call, including members of the NRC staff, Xcel Energy, Entergy, Dominion, PSE&G, Winston & Strawn, Cooper Nuclear Station, local and State government officials from New York and Vermont, Beyond Nuclear, and other stakeholders. Enclosure 1 lists the meeting attendees and the conference call attendees (ADAMS Accession No. ML083500024)

A public meeting notice was issued on November 20, 2008, and was posted on the NRC's external (public) web page. The notice included the meeting agenda and Draft RIS 2001-07, Rev. 1, which was also available as a handout at the meeting. Enclosure 2 includes the meeting agenda and Draft RIS 2001-07, Rev.1 (ADAMS Accession No. ML083250163).

The purpose of the meeting was to provide the public with an opportunity to participate in the public meeting process by providing questions and comments on issues the stakeholders believed the NRC should consider prior to the issuance of the RIS 2001-07, Rev. 1. During the meeting, the NRC staff summarized the RIS 2001-07, Rev. 1 changes with respect to clarifying required information under 10 CFR 50.75, from voluntary information solicited in the RIS, and took questions and comments related to the RIS 2001-07, Rev. 1. Questions and comments came primarily from Bill Horin from Winston & Strawn, Paul Gunter from Beyond Nuclear, and Janice Dean from the State of NY Attorney General's Office.
