Don,

I spoke to Cheryl Antonio (PNL Health Physics contractor for Harris: Phone 509-376-7758) yesterday, and we discussed the two items from the 4.5 area of the Environmental Report review:

The first was concerning data provided from only the 2004 release data for liquid and gaseous to calculate Construction worker dose. Why was data not provided from other years? Was 2004 data the highest, typical value or were the other year's data not available?

The second was the question of whether the construction (in the existing Harris switchyard and the installation of the intake structure for the new plant) will result in less conservative individual construction worker doses (These areas were listed in both FSAR chapter 12 and Section 4.5 as being the only possible exceptions to work outside of the protective area.

Niether of these items were believed to be show-stoppers, but the additional data is necessary or the issue requires clarification.

These items can be reviewed on the site visit.
