Dear Licensing:

Please amend the above license to authorize Cardinal Health Nuclear Pharmacy Services (hereafter Cardinal Health) to perform the following as a service:

Dose Calibrator Calibrations

Cardinal Health will perform dose calibrator calibrations in accordance with previously submitted and approved procedures, derived from *Appendix O: NUREG 1556 Vol 13, Rev 1*. In accordance with this, Cardinal Health requests authorization to use the authorized material listed in License Condition 6.C (Technetium-99m) and 6.K (Sealed Sources) at temporary job sites in order to perform these calibration services. License Condition 11 currently allows Cardinal Health to use material listed in License Condition 6.M (leak test samples) at temporary job sites. All dose calibrator calibrations will be performed by or under the supervision of an Authorized Nuclear Pharmacist or Authorized User under this license.

Cardinal Health requests expedited processing of this request. The State of Kansas Department of Health and Environment requires the above referenced license to be specifically authorized to perform these services in order to receive reciprocity to perform these services within its jurisdiction.
