Dear Mr. Ward:

After a review of your October 2, 2008, letter and follow-up telephone conversation with Ms. Hecht, it has come to our attention that your NRC License No. 24-13365-01 contained an error in items 9.A., B., and G. Therefore, a corrected copy to Amendment No. 34 is being issued in lieu of a new amendment as requested in your October 2 letter.

In your July 16, 2007, application for renewal, you specifically identified and described various research activities, including but not limited to custom organic synthesis, using certain radionuclides. When we issued the amendment renewing your license we did not clearly describe these uses. Items 9.A., B., and G. have been re-written to clarify these activities as described in your July 16 application. Enclosed is a corrected copy of your NRC license reflecting the change. We apologize for any inconvenience this may have caused you.
