I apologize for the oversight in not specifying the changes to analytical and environmental samples categories of our license. Therefore, in correcting my oversight, I wish to request that Item 8.B. and 8.H. both be limited to a possession limit of 10 milliCuries per sample with a total possession limit of 100 milliCuries for each of these listings.


As far as the limitations for possession of sealed sources containing radioisotopes of requiring Increased Controls, a condition that would state that the "Aggregate activity of all sealed sources in possession that are subject to the requirements of Increased Security Controls shall be balanced by use of the Unity Rule and formula, and possession shall be maintained below 1.0."
