This letter is in response to the November 25, 2008 NRC letter regarding the proposed change in regulatory authority. At this time, Atlantic Geotechnical Services, Inc. (AGS) work activities are limited to job sites in the Commonwealth of Virginia. Although our existing license allows AGS to use our licensed material in Non-Agreement states, we presently do not require an NRC license for temporary job sites in Non-Agreement states.

Therefore, please amend our license authorizing work activities in the Commonwealth of Virginia only. Should we require use of our licensed material in other states, we will either file NRC Form 241 for Non-Agreement states or file with the specific Agreement state where our temporary job sites may be located.

We hope this provides the information needed and is consistent with NRC guidelines. Please call if you require additional information.
