License Condition implementation for the National Source Tracking System (NSTS). To be consistent for the startup of the NSTS computer database as imposed by 10 CFR Part 20.

The licensee must comply with the initial inventory reporting requirement in 10 CFR 20.2207(h) for nationally tracked sources by the dates imposed in the paragraph. The licensee must also comply with the reporting requirements for transactions involving nationally tracked sources in 10 CFR § 20.2207. This section includes the requirement to report any manufacture, transfer, receipt, disassembly, or disposal of a nationally tracked source, otherwise allowed by this license, by the close of the next business day after the transaction.
