To Whom It May Concern:

1. You requested authorization for materials permitted by 10 CFR 35.100 and 35.200 for Drs. Popovich and Swart. Due to changes in NRC regulations, the ABR certification submitted for Dr. Swart is not recognized by the NRC under 10 CFR Part 35. Beginning in June 2006, an ABR certificate in Diagnostic Radiology is acceptable only if "AU eligible" appears above the ABR seal. A copy of Dr. Popovich's ABR certification was not submitted. Please be advised that the same NRC regulations would also apply to Dr. Popovich (i.e. ABR certificate in Diagnostic Radiology is acceptable only if "AU eligible" appears above the ABR seal).

Alternatively, you may choose to resubmit Form 313A (AUD) (please fill out sections 3a and 3b on pages 2-3, demonstrating that the number of hours in classroom/lab training plus supervised work experience totaled 700 and included at least 80 classroom/lab, and all listed elements were included in the training) detailing Drs. Popovich and Swart's T&E and have it signed by a preceptor with the same authorization as requested (page 4, "Part II Preceptor Attestation"). 2. You requested to remove Dr. Dennis Burton from your material license. Please be advised, Dr. Burton is the only individual authorized for any byproduct material permitted by 10 CFR 31.11 on your material license. Please confirm one of the following statements:
 - a. These materials are used at your facility and you wish to name a different authorized user (specify name), or
 - b. These materials have never been possessed at your facility and you wish to remove this authorization from your license, or
 - c. These materials have been used previously, are not now in use, and you wish to remove this authorization from your license. If this statement applies, you must submit a listing of the radionuclides used under 10 CFR 31.11 (a) and a closeout survey of the area(s) where material identified in 10 CFR 31.11(a) was used. The survey(s) must receive NRC approval in order for the area(s) to be released for unrestricted use.

Please note that you may not reply to this letter by return e-mail. Your reply must be in writing by letter or facsimile. You may fax your signed response to 610-337-5269, referencing mail control 143009. When you send the fax, you may wish to leave a voicemail or e-mail message to alert me to look for it. If we do not receive a reply from you within 30 calendar days from the date of this e-mail, we will assume that you do not wish to pursue your application. We appreciate your patience and attention to detail in documenting compliance with these complex,
