Rio Algom Mining LLC ("RAML") hereby gives notice that Uranium Resources, Inc. ("URI") and Billiton Investment 15 B.V. have entered into a mutual Consent to Terminate the Membership Interest Purchase Agreement dated October 12, 2007 (the "Purchase Agreement") pursuant to which URI was to acquire ownership and control of RAML. NRC's consent to the such transaction and change of control was requested by application submitted December 18, 2007 (TAC number J00554). Termination of the Purchase Agreement means that the proposed indirect transfer or change of control with respect to materials license SUA-1473 will no longer occur. Accordingly, RAML withdraws its application for NRC's consent to an indirect change of control.
