Dear Dr. Ricci:

Enclosed is Amendment No. 26 amending your NRC Material License No. 24-25816-01 in accordance with your request which authorizes Dr. Steinberg for 10 CFR 35.300 material, limited to iodine-131. Please note that the changes made to your license are printed in **bold** font. Also note that we have not added the radioactive material as requested in your November 1, 2008 letter. These nuclides are now included in the new definition of "byproduct material" and as such, are included in material covered under 10 CFR 35, Section 35.200 (thallium-201, gallium-67, iodine-123, and indium-111), and Section 35.65 (cobalt-57 as a calibration/reference source).

Please note however, that 10 CFR 35.65 limits possession of calibration/reference sources to activity levels no greater than 30 millicuries. Based upon a telephone conversation between Ms. Marcia West and me on December 15, it is our understanding that your cobalt-57 source(s) fall within this limit, therefore this nuclide was not added to your license.

Please review the enclosed document carefully and be sure that you understand all conditions. If there are any errors or questions, please notify the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, Region III office at (630) 829-9887 so that we can provide appropriate corrections and answers.
