



Please remove the Kevex Analyzer from our NRC license number 29-30495-01. We continue to own and operate a Metallurgist Pro XRF metal analyzer that contains CAD-109 and Iron-55.

Dear Mr. Tiziani:

On November 2 and 3, 2006, Steven Courtemanche of this office conducted a safety inspection by telephone of activities authorized by the above listed NRC license at your facility at Foot of Hawkins Street, Newark, New Jersey. The inspection was limited to a review of your use of licensed material prior to June 2002 and to the disposal of licensed material. The findings of the inspection were discussed with Paul Vastola of your organization at the conclusion of the inspection.

Within the scope of this inspection, no violations were identified.

It is our understanding that you currently do not possess any licensed material authorized by your NRC license. The Kevex metal analyzer was transferred to AEA Technology QSA in June of 2002 for proper disposal. Also, it is our understanding that the metal analyzer currently in use is possessed under a general license. In order to terminate your license, you must submit a written request stating that you want to have your license terminated. The request should reference your August 12, 2002, letter already on file and have, as an enclosure, the most recent leak test of the sealed sources or a statement indicating whether any sources were found to be leaking and actions taken to remove the contamination. NRC Form 314, Certificate of Disposition of Materials is included for your use.


