1/8 I spoke with Mr. Azir. He was of the opinion that the NRC had inspected their licensed program a few months ago. He was not able to participate in the inspection but his physicist accompanied the inspector. I requested that he talk to the physicist and determine if it was a State of New Jersey inspector and provide me with the name of the inspector.

1/9 Ms. Clay called and informed me that the inspector that came in December 2008 was from the State of New Jersey. It was a preliminary site visit so that the State license could be issued. No licensed activities have been performed as the equipment must still be calibrated. Ms. Clay did not expect to administer licensed material to patients for 6 – 8 weeks. I informed Ms. Clay that, based on her information, the inspection would be deferred until the July – September timeframe.
