Dear Mr. Ganz:

By letter dated December 11, 2008, as supplemented on December 22, 2008, (Agencywide Documents Access and Management System Accession Nos. ML083500374 and ML0836403110, respectively) Foster Wheeler Ltd. submitted an application seeking Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) consent to the indirect transfer of control of Special Nuclear Materials (SNM) License No. 2512 for the Idaho Spent Fuel Facility.

In general, no additional changes to the application will be allowed except for those minor changes that result in responding to a request for additional information. Additional changes, supplements, or enhancements may be treated as a new application. The NRC anticipates completing its review by January 30, 2009, if there is no need for additional information. This represents a highly accelerated schedule, which should not be viewed as a precedent for future requests for indirect license transfers.

Please notify me, in writing at your earliest opportunity, of any circumstance that may impact the schedule.
