Please note that, in preparing this amendment, I did not extend your line item listing in Subitem Nos. 6 through 9 to include your requests in the letter dated September 30, 2008, items 5.a. and 5.d. This is because the provisions in 10 CFR 31.8 and 31.12 appeared to apply and capture these authorizations without explicitly listing them on your specific license.

In accordance with my telephone discussion with Michelle Bresnahan on December 30, 2008, the materials listed in Subitem Nos. 6 through 9 G. and H. were not deleted at this time as I am awaiting the submittal of an acknowledgment of receipt from you, concerning the transfer of the Troxler sources. Please submit this information, with an appropriate cover letter, to my attention, and reference it as "additional information to control no. 317559." We will then continue our review.

Also, for your information, your facsimile sent on December 30, 2008, stated that 9 pages would be transmitted; we only received 8 pages as the last page was left blank. Please let me know if that ninth page was germane to this review.

NRC's Regulatory Issue Summary (RIS) 2005-31 provides criteria to identify security-related sensitive information and guidance for handling and marking of such documents. This ensures that potentially sensitive information is not made publicly available through ADAMS, the NRC's electronic document system.
