Dear Administrative Judges:


As I indicated in the telephone conference call held on January 14, 2009, the NRC Staff ("Staff") has issued two reports concerning its audits of the license renewal application ("LRA") for Indian Point Nuclear Generating Units 2 and 3. In addition, the Staff's Draft Supplemental Environmental Impact Statement, issued on December 22, 2008, and referred to in my letter to the Licensing Board of December 24, 2008, has now been printed and bound.
