Enclosed is Amendment No. 08 to your NRC Material License No. 24-32517-01 in accordance with your request. Please note that the changes made to your license are printed in **bold** font.

**Please note that I authorized both your old and new HDR sealed sources and devices at this time because it was not clear from your letter dated October 2, 2008, whether you were still in possession of the old sources/device.**

**Also, in order for us to delete your old HDR sealed sources and device from the license you must explicitly request that we do so and submit appropriate supporting information. This information includes the final leak test on the last sealed source you possessed for the old HDR device and the "acknowledgment of receipt" paperwork from the vendor who took possession of the final sealed source. You can submit this amendment request to my attention as "additional information to control number 317545."**

NRC's Regulatory Issue Summary (RIS) 2005-31 provides criteria to identify security-related sensitive information and guidance for handling and marking of such documents. This ensures that potentially sensitive information is not made publicly available through ADAMS, the NRC's electronic document system.

Pursuant to NRC's RIS 2005-31 and in accordance with 10 CFR 2.390, the enclosed license document is exempt from public disclosure because its disclosure to unauthorized individuals could present a security vulnerability.
