The Radiological Emergency Preparedness (REP) Program staff from the FEMA Region IV Office has reviewed the offsite radiological emergency plans for the LNP COL application, however, the documents submitted were not adequate to support a complete review.

The staff in Region IV has determined that the Marion County Emergency Operations Plan, and the Marion County Radiological Emergency Preparedness Plan, have not been received and were not incorporated into the COL application. The Acceptance Review of this application can not be concluded until the referenced plans are received. The absence of these plans has a direct impact on the schedule and timeliness associated with the review process.
