This RAI addresses the Turbine Area Ventilation System, as discussed in Section 9.4.4 of the Final Safety Analysis Report (FSAR), as submitted in Part 2 of the CCNPP Unit 3 Combined License Application (COLA). A response to RAI Question 09.04.04-1 will be provided by April 30, 2009.

UniStar Nuclear recognizes that this date significantly impacts the Staff's review of this section of the FSAR. We are working with our vendors to reduce the timeframe for obtaining design information of the Turbine Area Ventilation System and to provide this response at an earlier date.
