

Possession incident to distribution of electron tubes, spark gaps, surge arrestors, Transmit/Receive ("TR") Limiters and Transient Protection Units ("TPU") manufactured by E2V Ltd., to persons exempt from the requirements for a license pursuant to the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (USNRC) License No. 31-23630-02E.

10. Licensed material shall be stored at the licensee's installation specified in Condition 2 of this license.
11. Licensed material shall be used by, or under the supervision of, Peter Fochi (Radiation Safety Officer).
12. The licensee shall not accept any shipment of electron tubes and related devices from the manufacturer unless it is accompanied by the manufacturer's certification that it has been tested and found to be free of radioactive material contamination.

13. The licensee shall conduct a physical inventory every six (6) months to account for all electron tubes and related devices received and possessed under the License. The records of the inventories shall be maintained for three (3) years from the date of the inventory for inspection by the Department, and shall include the quantities and kinds of licensed material, Manufacturer's Name and Model No., location of the electron tubes and related devices, the date of the inventory and the name of the person who performed it.
14. Electron tubes and related devices containing licensed material that are found to be damaged, or which cannot otherwise be distributed, shall be returned to the manufacturer.
15. A. The licensee shall maintain a current copy of its USNRC License No. 31-23630-02E on file with the Department. A copy of each amendment to that license shall be submitted to the Department within fifteen (15) days of its receipt by the licensee.
- B. The licensee shall immediately notify the Department should its USNRC License No. 31-23630-02E be terminated or suspended.
16. Except as specifically provided otherwise in this License, the licensee shall conduct its program in accordance with the statements, representation and procedures contained in the documents, including any enclosures, listed below. The Department's Regulations shall govern, unless the statements, representation and procedures in the licensee's application and correspondence are more restrictive than the Regulations.
