My name is John H. Luton. I am President of the First National Bank of Granbury, a rancher, and have been a resident of Hood County all my life and have been very aware of the Comanche Peak power plant in Somervell County.

Comanche Peak has been a good neighbor to the surrounding area. They run their operation in a very environmentally conscious manner.

Texas needs reliable, clean power. The expansion of the current plant allows the wise use of the existing infrastructure – cooling lake, transmission lines, and the like with little or no impact on surrounding landowners or the environment.
