

Additionally, we commit to provide radiation safety and protection training to ancillary personnel involved in the new brachytherapy program. All individuals working with or around licensed materials will receive safety instructions commensurate with their assigned duties, and if it is likely that they could receive doses over 1 mSv (100 mrem) in a year, they will receive instructions as specified by 10 CFR 19.12. The training will occur prior to program initiation and annual thereafter.
