On January 15, 2009, a call was conducted with Nuclear Fuel Services (NFS) to discuss additional information regarding Request for Additional Information (RAI) Question 22 for the new CD Line. The following individuals participated:

The information proposed a definition of high consequence for dermal exposure to dilute hydrofluoric acid (HF) solutions. In addition, the information proposed 2 accident sequences with passive controls (pipes) and an administrative control (procedure and training) for motorized vehicles in Building 301. NRC asked if there would be any motorized vehicles in Building 301. NFS responded that no motorized vehicles would be in the building for normal operations. However, a forklift could be used if large equipment had to be moved.

NRC noted that there are ongoing efforts to develop a consensus standard for dermal exposure, but the information provided by NFS was reasonable for this amendment. When this information is submitted formally, this issue will be closed. NFS stated that it would prepare a letter to submit the information.

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
