PROGRAM SCOPE

The licensee was a civil engineering company which performed soil moisture/density testing for road and building sites in the Traverse City and Petoskey areas in Michigan. The licensee possessed and used one gauge as described on the license. The gauge had been used ten times in 2008, mostly from May through November. The gauge was secured in accordance with 10 CFR 30.34(i) both in the licensee's facility and in vehicles. The licensee did not perform any service or maintenance activities on the gauge. The gauge was used by two gauge users who had completed gauge training, either from the manufacturer or from an area college. The licensee knew where to obtain a survey instrument if needed during an emergency situation.

Performance Observations

No temporary job site was available for observation at the time of the inspection. The inspector observed gauge storage at the licensee's facility, and licensee personnel described gauge use, transport, storage in a vehicle, and emergency procedures. The inspector identified no concerns with these activities. Interviews with licensee personnel indicated adequate knowledge of radiation safety procedures and policies. Surveys of the gauge storage area indicated radiation levels appropriate for unrestricted areas and consistent with licensee postings.
