NEI introduced the enclosed White Paper, entitled "Regulatory Issue Screening Process," during the Licensing Forum in Alexandria, VA earlier this week. It describes a proposed process for screening plant-specific inspection findings and licensing actions to identify issues that could be addressed and resolved as generic issues. It also recommends the use of some form of mediation to resolve long-term disagreements about issues that do not have a significant safety or risk impact.
