AP1000 Combined License Application Departure Report Update**

Progress Energy – Carolinas submitted an application, dated February 18, 2008, for a combined license for two AP1000 passive pressurized water reactors to be located at the Shearon Harris Nuclear Power Plant site in Wake County, North Carolina. Part 7 of the application is the "Departures and Exemptions Requests."

The purpose of this letter is to provide an update to the report describing plant-specific departures from the AP1000 Design Control Document (i.e., Departures Report) as required by 10 CFR 52, Appendix D, paragraph X.B.1 and X.B.3.b.
