Dear Ms Quinn,

By letter dated February 27, 2008, Entergy Operations Incorporated (EOI) submitted to the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) a combined license application for a proposed nuclear power plant at Entergy's Grand Gulf site in Mississippi. In accordance with established protocol, FEMA reviewed the offsite emergency response plans submitted or referenced in the application and by letter dated November 14, 2008, transmitted Requests for Additional Information (RAIs) to Entergy with a 45 day response period. The purpose of this correspondence is to satisfy the 45 day response requirement in your transmittal.

FEMA Region IV determined that there are 7 RAIs associated with the State and/or County plans, and issued an Interim Findings Report on October 10, 2008. By letter dated November 25, 2008 Entergy requested the assistance of the Mississippi Emergency Management Agency (MEMA) in order to resolve the FEMA Region IV RAIs. Entergy understands that MEMA has been working diligently with FEMA Region IV in order to obtain closure of the 7 RAIs.

FEMA Region VI determined that there are 37 RAIs associated with the State and/or Parish plans. By letter dated November 25, 2008, Entergy requested the assistance of the Louisiana Department of Environmental Quality (LDEQ) Emergency & Radiological Services Division in order to resolve the FEMA Region VI RAIs. Entergy understands that LDEQ has been working diligently with FEMA Region VI in order to obtain closure of the 37 RAIs.

By way of consultation with responsible individuals in the states of Louisiana and Mississippi, in addition to FEMA Regions IV and VI, Entergy understands that the majority of RAIs are resolved or near resolution, and that Interim Finding Reports with Open Items or with Statement of Reasonable Assurance will be issued from the FEMA Regions to FEMA Headquarters in the near future. Entergy will continue to work with responsible parties to facilitate closure of all FEMA RAIs.
