Dear Sir:

Florida Power Corporation (FPC), doing business as Progress Energy Florida, Inc., was informed by the NRC Project Manager of a typographical error contained in License Amendment Request (LAR) #300, Revision 0, which was recently submitted to the NRC (Reference 1). The purpose of this letter is to provide a correction to a date that was stated in the cover letter of LAR #300, Revision 0.

Regulation 10 CFR 50.55a, requires adoption of the Edition of the ASME Boiler and Pressure Vessel Code referenced in the regulations 12 months prior to the implementation of the next 10-year Inservice Testing interval. Reference 1 incorrectly identified May 12, 2007, as this period for Crystal River Unit 3 (CR-3). By letter dated July 28, 2008 (Reference 2), the NRC was notified that implementation of the Fourth 10-year Inservice Testing Program at CR-3 would begin on May 11, 2009.

Therefore, this correspondence is being provided to correct the date identified in LAR #300, Revision 0, for the Code of Federal Regulations review performed 12 months prior to the implementation of the next 10-year Inservice Testing interval at CR-3, to May 11, 2008.

No new regulatory commitments are made in this letter.



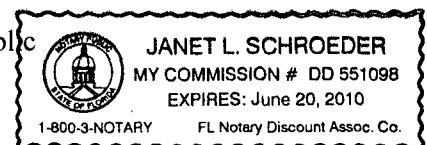
