Thank you for the opportunity to comment.

I am writing in regard to Docket ID NRC-2008-0566, the proposed Fermi 3 Nuclear Power Plant in Monroe, Michigan.

I am concerned about the impact of radiation exposure on the elderly, immunosuppressed persons, children, and the population in general in Monroe County. It seems quite peculiar that Monroe's mortality rate is above that of Michigan for the years 2000-2005, all cancers combined (ICD-10 codes COO-D48.9).

Will the NRC be asking the Health Department to investigate this discrepancy? And how can we be assured that increasing nuclear power generation does not put our citizens, especially children and young adults at risk?

Thank you for giving serious consideration to these issues before moving forward with plans to build Fermi 3.
