DECLARATION IN SUPPORT OF ECOLOGY PARTY OF FLORIDA PETITION TO INTERVENE IN DOCKET 52-029 and 52-30

Under penalty of perjury, I, December Duke McSherry, declare as follows:

- 1. Address / proximity to proposed reactor site: I, December Duke McSherry, reside 15212 SW 79^{th} Avenue, Archer, Florida 32618. My residence, which I own , lies approximately 36 miles from the proposed site of a new nuclear plant, for which Progress Energy Florida has submitted a combined construction permit and operating license application ("COLA") to the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission ("NRC" or "Commission").
- 2. I am concerned that if the NRC grants Progress Energy Florida's COLA, the construction and operation of the proposed nuclear power plant could adversely affect my health and safety and the integrity of the environment where I live. I am particularly concerned about the risk of accidental releases of radioactive material to the environment, and the potential harm to groundwater supplies and local surface waters.
- 3. I am a member of the Ecology Party of Florida
- 3. In order to ensure that the licensing decision for the proposed Levy County 1 & 2 nuclear power plants protects my interests in a safe and healthful environment, I have authorized the Ecology Party of Florida to represent me in any licensing proceeding and/or related rulemaking proceeding that concerns the safety and environmental impacts of the proposed nuclear power plant in Levy County, Florida. I have also authorized the Ecology Party of Florida to take any legal actions that are necessary to ensure that the licensing proceeding and the rulemaking proceeding are conducted fairly, efficiently, and in a manner that provides for the full consideration of all licensing issues that could affect my safety and the health of my environment.

I declare under penalty of perjury that the foregoing facts are true and correct and that any expressions of opinion are based on my best judgment.
