Subject: Comment on the scope of the environmental review

Having attended your scoping meeting and reading extensively on the proposed Fermi 3 nuclear power plant, I am shocked that you would even give it a consideration. There are so many reasons to oppose it but I'll focus on a few.

There is still no final storage solution for nuclear waste that remains deadly for 100,000 years.
