Reference: Letter from Sam Shakir (AREVA), EREF-08-010, to NRC, "Application for a Uranium Enrichment Facility License Under 10 CFR 70, 'Domestic Licensing of Special Nuclear Material'," dated December 30, 2008

By letter dated December 30, 2008, AREVA Enrichment Services (AES) LLC submitted an application (Reference) for a license to construct and operate a gas centrifuge uranium enrichment plant designated the Eagle Rock Enrichment Facility (EREF). As noted in the letter transmitting the application, since certain portions of the application contain classified information, those portions would be transmitted separately in accordance with 10 CFR 95.39, "External Transmission of Documents and Material." Specifically, those portions of the application are: 1) a section of the Fundamental Nuclear Material Control Plan (FNMCP) and, 2) the section of the decommissioning cost estimate dealing with the centrifuges and associated pipe work.

Therefore, these classified portions of the application are submitted to the NRC as enclosures to this letter in accordance with 10 CFR 95.39. This letter and its enclosures are being transmitted from Enrichment Technology Company Limited in the United Kingdom.
