Subject: Waste Confidence Rule

To whom it concerns;

I am writing in reference to the Waste Confidence Rule. Since the early days of the nuclear industry, confidence in finding a safe way to dispose of waste has been based primarily on faith, not science. The failed, extremely expensive foible of the Yucca Mountain Repository is a case in point. There still has NOT been a safe disposal facility site either found or built. Further, I feel that the NRC should look at the social, environmental and economic consequences of a spent fuel accident on a site by site basis, as a requirement of NEPA, before issuing any license extension or new license. The NRC must also incorporate the findings of the National Academy of Science study on spent fuel security that found water storage in above ground pools such as those at Vermont Yankee to be extremely vulnerable to malicious attack.
