
The following additional information is needed to review your request to terminate your NRC radioactive materials license.

Please note, we cannot authorize the release of your facility and terminate your license, until we have received and reviewed a copy of the results of your close-out survey. The close-out survey needs to include the following information:

- a. Please complete and submit the accompanying NRC Form 314, "Certificate of Disposal of Materials".
- b. Please list the radionuclides that were actually used or stored at your facility at 3830 Shore Drive, Indianapolis, Indiana.
- c. Please submit information on any leaking sources used or stored at your facility at 3830 Shore Drive, Indianapolis, Indiana. Information needs to include the isotope, amount of leakage, contamination of other areas or personnel, description of the cleanup, and disposition of the source(s). If you did not have any leaking sources, please state so. Please submit a copy of the last leak test for the sources that was current when the sealed sources were transferred to Advantage Diagnostics in Beachwood, Ohio.
- d. Please confirm that all radionuclides have been removed from the facility at 3830 Shore Drive, Indianapolis, Indiana. Also, please confirm that radioactive materials were not received or used at 7855 South Emerson Avenue, Indianapolis, Indiana.
- e. Please submit a copy of Advantage Diagnostics' (Beachwood, Ohio) radioactive materials license.
