**INYO COUNTY FEBRUARY 2009 CERTIFICATION OF
LICENSING SUPPORT NETWORK SUPPLEMENTATION**

Each potential party is required by 10 C.F.R. § 2.1003(e) to supplement, on a continuing basis, its documentary material made available on the Licensing Support Network (LSN) with additional material created or discovered after the date of its certification of November 15, 2006. Pursuant to the requirements of 10 C.F.R. § 2.1003(e), the Pre-Application Presiding Officer (PAPO) Board has ordered in the Revised Second Case Management Order dated July 6, 2007, that each potential party make such supplementation on or before the first day of each month following its initial certification, and file to that effect.

On November 15, 2006, Inyo County, California filed its initial certification. As the official responsible for the administration of Inyo County's Yucca Mountain Repository Assessment Office to duly supplement the LSN collection of electronic files of documentary material, I hereby certify that, pursuant to procedures established under 10

C.F.R. § 2.1009(a)(2), and the Revised Second Case Management Order dated July 6, 2007, to the best of my knowledge, subject to the document review being conducted by the County of Inyo which is described below, all documentary material specified in 10 C.F.R. § 2.1003 has been identified and made available in accordance with the requirements of 10 C.F.R. § 2.1011(b)(2). Beginning in January, the County of Inyo began a review of all documents in its possession and in the possession of its contractors that pertain to the Yucca Mountain Repository to ensure that all necessary documents have been identified and filed on the LSN. Based on the review, during February 2009, the County of Inyo submitted additional documents to the LSN and additional documents will continue to be submitted until the review is completed in early March, 2009. This certification covers any documentary material identified and made available via the LSN through February 17, 2009.

Inyo County will continue to supplement its collection of documentary material on the LSN as required by 10 C.F.R. § 2.1003(e) and the Revised Second Case Management Order dated July 6, 2007.
